Born in Saint-Hyacinthe in 1965, Dominique Gaucher has worked for over 25 years as a backdrop and scenery painter for opera, theatre and film productions. In parallel to this career, he has painted professionally since 1996 and in 2001, he received a Masters of Fine Arts from the Universitdu Quec Montrl. He has participated in many expositions in Montreal in the Maison de la Culture, Galerie de Bellefeuille, the Centre National dExposition de Jonquie, as well as in Vancouver and Edmonton. In 2008, he was invited to participate in the Quebec Gold exhibition in Reims, France. In 2009 Gaucher designed the torch for the Vancouver Winter Olympics, where he was also featured in a solo exhibition. His paintings are part of many national and international collections. Gaucher lives and works in Montreal.
